Rat Protects Itself with Poison

Scientists have long believed that the African Crested Rat is poisonous. However, a team of researchers from New York, the United Kingdom, and Kenya, have discovered that the rat, which lives in the northeastern part of Africa, protects itself from predation by chewing the bark of a poisonous tree, and then smearing the mushed material on its fur. The only other animal known to do something similar is the hedgehog, which occasionally kills poisonous frogs and spread their venom on its spikes. Normally, the African Crested Rat looks like any other rat with long grey hair. When attacked, however, it does not attempt to run away (it is very slow), but instead exposes poison-coated black and white striped hairs on its sides. These hairs have a special structure that draws poison up them so that they can hold the largest possible amount of toxin. The scientists are still trying to figure out how the rat can survive chewing the bark, which comes from the Poison Arrow Tree. The poison is so strong that traditionally, people have used it to coat arrows when hunting elephants. In strong enough doses, the poison causes heart attacks, so scientists hope that by studying the rat's tolerance to it, they could discover new treatments to human heart problems!
